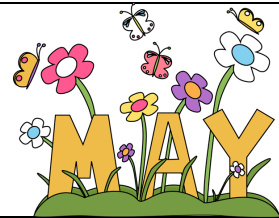

## From The Desk of Principal Virginia Bolano:

**Retirement:** Mrs. Karen Manchester, our school secretary, retired from her position just before April vacation. We wish all the best on her retirement. She will be missed at Scott School. Substitute secretary, Ann Oliver, will be in the position until the vacancy is filled.

**Dress Code:** Please review the dress code with your child(ren) now that the weather is getting warmer. Please keep in mind that mid sections of the body must be covered, this includes while sitting down. Spaghetti strap tops and basketball jerseys cannot be worn without a t-shirt underneath. Shorts and skirts are acceptable, as long as they reach the fingertips when arms are down by one's side. Also, flip flops can be very dangerous during recess time and are therefore discouraged.

**PARCC Testing:** PARCC testing will conclude for students in grades 3-6 on May 19th.

**NECAP Science Testing:** Students in grade 4 will take the NECAP Science test on May 9th, 10th and 11th.

**Kindergarten Enrollment:** Children who live in the Scott School area and who will attain 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2017 are eligible for enrollment. **KIDS Day:** KIDS Day is for incoming Kindergarten students and their parents/guardians. It will be held on Thursday, June 1st at 9:30 a.m. in the lunchroom. All incoming Kindergarten students must be enrolled prior to attending KIDS Day. The program consists of hearing about Scott School programs, tour of the school, visiting the classroom, meeting the teacher and experiencing and learning about the bus safety rules. The program typically lasts about one hour.

**Moving from the Scott School area or 6th Graders who will not be attending Winman:** We are currently planning for the 2017-2018 school year. If you are planning to move out of the Scott School area, or your 6th grader is not attending Winman next year, please notify the school secretary at 734-3585. This will allow us with the most accurate information in which to plan classes for next year, as well as to prepare records for your child's new school.
