### Dress Code:

*...“In adopting this code, the Warwick Public Schools hope to create a clean, healthy, and safe environment which shall be conducive to good education and beneficial to all students. It is the School Committee’s intent that students wear appropriate, clean nondisruptive clothing, and in keeping with that intent, students are required to comply with the following:*

- 1. Articles of clothing must cover the torso, to be appropriate to the school environment and/or nondisruptive in the classroom.*
- 2. Sunglasses may not be worn in classrooms unless medical reasons exists.*
- 3. No hats may be worn within the building.*
- 4. No clothing that promotes alcohol, drugs, violence, profanity, or is obscene as that word is construed by the United States Supreme Court decisions shall be worn in a school building.*

*Coats worn as outerwear may not be worn within the school building during school hours.*

*The School Committee recognizes that a student may be exempted from the provisions of the dress code due to health or handicapping conditions... “*
